Sub: A Uniform ban on Fishing by all fishing vessels at East Coast and West

The president of India is pleased to impose a uniform ban on fishing by all fishing vessels in the Indian Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) beyond territorial waters on the East Coast including Andaman & Nicobar Islands and West Coast including Lakshadweep Islands as per periods mentioned below for conservation and effective management of fishery resources and also for sea safety reasons:

East Coast - from 15th April to 31st May 2014 (both days inclusive) (47 days). West Coast - From 15th June to 31st July2014 (both days inclusive) (47 days).
