It was informed by E.Co.Railway authorities that, joint examination of Inward / Out-ward rakes in R&D Yard will be conducted from **07.04.2025** to assess Damage & Deficiencies of rakes for a period of 7 days, in R&D Yard, so as to arrive damage & deficiency unit rate per wagon.

During the joint examination, an intensive examination of Inward / Out-ward rakes will be carried out, so that minute details of damages can be recorded, which will form base for calculating damage & deficiency rate per wagon.

Hence, in view of the above, it is informed to take utmost care during loading / unloading of rakes and avoid damages & deficiencies to the railway wagons by adhering safe handling practices.
