Due to this menace spilled cargo is sticking to the road and becoming slippery, which may lead to accidents and causing damage to the road thereby diminishing the service life of the road.

Keeping in view of the above, all the Port users are hereby directed to cover the trucks with tarpaulins in the stack yard itself and not to over load the trucks.

The above shall be complied with immediate effect.
